Universities, companies large and small, institutes and government bodies can all be funded. This workshop will introduce the new scheme of programmes of Horizon 2020. The topics include Horizon 2020 overview, current Horizon 2020 financial rules, preparing for Horizon 2020, eligible costs + VAT, open access and participant portal.
